**In order to ensure success in the RAI Volunteer Tutor Program,
we suggest the following guideline for students and parents:**

Students:

- Attend school regularly in order to receive the full benefit of the tutoring program. Every absence means it will take longer to achieve your goals!
- Cooperate with your tutor. The more you can accomplish in a session, the sooner you will be on your way to reading excellence!
- Have fun learning to read!
- Practice your reading skills at home.

Parents:

- Read to children when they are at home. Ask your child to read to you. (See our tips for reading to children.)
- Cut down on t.v. watching time.
- Encourage regular school attendance.
- Call school if your child will be absent on a tutoring day.
- Communicate with your child's classroom teacher frequently to check on reading improvement.
